BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Why your relationships keep teaching you the same lesson

Most relationship advice is universal. Be yourself. Communicate. Know your worth. And yet — you may still find yourself in the same dynamic, with a different person, feeling the same old ache. Not because something is wrong with you. But because you have not yet been given a map that is specific to how you are built to love.

Your Venus sign is that map. It reveals not just what you are drawn to, but what you genuinely need to feel safe, chosen, and alive in a relationship. Not the version of you that adapts. Not what looks good. What your soul actually requires.

Read your sign. Sit with it. Notice what lands — especially the parts that feel uncomfortably accurate.

“When you understand what you are designed to need, you stop abandoning yourself to make a relationship work.”

STEP ONE

How to find your Venus sign

Your Venus sign is not the same as your Sun sign. To find it, you need your exact date of birth, time of birth, and place of birth.

Go to astro.com → Free Horoscopes → Extended Chart Selection. Look for the Venus symbol (♀) next to one of the 12 signs. That is your Venus sign.

If you do not know your birth time, your Venus sign can often still be identified — unless Venus changed signs on your birth date. In that case, a reading with me will give you certainty.

THE FOUNDATION

What Venus actually tells you

Venus in your birth chart governs how you give and receive love, what makes you feel valued, what you find irresistible, and what you quietly require from a partner — even if you have never said it out loud.

It also shows where you tend to compromise too much, settle for almost-right, or attract partners who cannot quite meet you at your depth. Understanding your Venus is not self-indulgence. It is the kind of self-knowledge that changes who you choose — and why.

Find your sign below. Each profile includes how that Venus placement loves, what it is drawn to in a partner, and one question to sit with.

■ VENUS IN ARIES

Love as pursuit, spark, and aliveness

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves fast, fiercely, and without apology

A woman with Venus in Aries does not wait to be chosen — she knows what she wants and she moves toward it. She loves with her whole chest, intensely and immediately. But she needs challenge, independence, and the feeling that the relationship is alive. Routine is the death of her desire.

She feels most loved when you match her energy, admire her boldness, and are not intimidated by her fire.

To love her well: keep the spark alive with spontaneity and emotional directness. Never make her feel like she has to dim herself to keep you comfortable.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to confidence and a woman who knows her own mind

A man with Venus in Aries is attracted to women who carry themselves with certainty. He needs to feel the pursuit — not games, but genuine aliveness. A woman who is sure of herself, passionate about her life, and does not need his validation is profoundly attractive to him.

He is drawn to independent, spirited women who are enthusiastic about life and unafraid to take up space.

To make him feel loved: let him lead sometimes, meet his passion with your own, and never let things go completely flat.

REFLECT

“Am I choosing someone who makes me feel alive — or someone who feels safe precisely because they do not challenge me?”

■ VENUS IN TAURUS

Love as steadiness, presence, and physical warmth

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves slowly, devotedly, and with all her senses

A woman with Venus in Taurus does not fall quickly, but when she does, she loves deeply and stays. She needs comfort, beauty, consistency, and touch. She is not asking for grand gestures. She is asking to feel settled — to know that the love around her is real and it is not going anywhere.

She feels most loved when you are fully present, affectionate without agenda, and you create a life that feels beautiful and secure.

To love her well: be patient and consistent. Small acts of care mean more to her than dramatic declarations. Show up the same way, over and over.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to calm, grounded femininity

A man with Venus in Taurus is attracted to women who feel settled in themselves — no performance, no chaos, just genuine warmth and ease. He is sensual and values physical presence, good taste, and emotional steadiness.

He is drawn to women with a soft, grounded presence who value quality, comfort, and real connection over excitement.

To make him feel loved: express affection physically and often. Never rush him emotionally. Loyalty is his love language — speak it back.

REFLECT

“Do I feel truly safe and nourished in this relationship — or am I mistaking comfort for settling?”

■ VENUS IN GEMINI

Love as conversation, play, and mental spark

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves through words, curiosity, and constant becoming

A woman with Venus in Gemini needs her mind to be met. She falls for wit, ideas, and someone who makes her laugh and think in equal measure. Emotional heaviness without lightness suffocates her. She wants a partner who is also a companion — someone she could talk to for hours.

She feels most loved when you engage her mind, surprise her, and never let the conversation go stale.

To love her well: stay mentally present, bring new ideas and experiences into the relationship, and never take things too seriously.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to quick-minded, expressive women

A man with Venus in Gemini falls for a woman who can hold a conversation across any topic, makes him laugh, and carries an energy that is light and adaptable. He needs to feel mentally stimulated, not just emotionally connected.

He is drawn to witty, curious, expressive women who are fun to be around and easy to talk to about anything.

To make him feel loved: keep communication flowing, stay open and playful, and avoid turning every conversation into an emotional excavation.

REFLECT

“Is this relationship feeding my mind as well as my heart — or am I waiting for it to get interesting?”

■ VENUS IN CANCER

Love as safety, tenderness, and emotional home

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves by creating a world where both people feel protected

A woman with Venus in Cancer needs to feel safe before she opens fully. Her love is deeply nurturing — she gives care naturally and generously. But she also needs to receive it. She is looking for a relationship that feels like home: warm, loyal, and emotionally honest.

She feels most loved when you are gentle with her feelings, show genuine affection, and make her feel like your safe place.

To love her well: be consistent and emotionally present. She does not need perfection. She needs to know you will not disappear when things get tender.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to warmth, care, and emotional depth

A man with Venus in Cancer is drawn to women who feel emotionally attuned and genuinely caring. He craves connection that has depth and sincerity — not performance. A woman who makes him feel emotionally important is deeply attractive to him.

He is drawn to nurturing, emotionally present women who value closeness and are not afraid of real intimacy.

To make him feel loved: offer tenderness, make him feel valued, and let him take care of you sometimes — he needs to feel needed.

REFLECT

“Do I feel emotionally safe enough in this relationship to be soft — or am I always bracing?”

■ VENUS IN LEO

Love as devotion, pride, and being truly seen

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves generously and needs to be loved back just as fully

A woman with Venus in Leo has a big heart and an even bigger capacity for love. She is loyal, warm, and devoted when she feels genuinely appreciated. But she needs to feel seen and celebrated — not taken for granted. She will give everything in a relationship, but she needs to know it is landing.

She feels most loved when you notice her, express genuine admiration, and make her feel like the person you chose — not just the person who is there.

To love her well: praise her, plan something that makes her feel special, and never let her fade into the background of her own relationship.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to presence, confidence, and a woman who carries herself

A man with Venus in Leo is attracted to women who walk into a room and own it — not arrogance, but presence. He wants someone he is proud to be with, who matches his warmth and is not intimidated by his intensity.

He is drawn to confident, charismatic women who carry grace and are not afraid to shine.

To make him feel loved: celebrate his strengths, respect his pride, and let him feel like your equal — not your project.

REFLECT

“Do I feel genuinely celebrated in this relationship — or am I performing love for someone who barely notices?”

■ VENUS IN VIRGO

Love as care, thoughtfulness, and quiet devotion

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves through acts of care and needs them returned with the same attention

A woman with Venus in Virgo expresses love in practical, precise ways. She notices everything. She remembers what you mentioned once in passing and does something about it. She is not loud about her love — but she is meticulous. She needs a partner who sees and values that.

She feels most loved when you are reliable, pay attention to the details, and show your love through consistent, thoughtful action.

To love her well: do not just tell her you care — show her. Keep your word. Handle things without being asked. That is her love language.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to composure, intelligence, and genuine substance

A man with Venus in Virgo is attracted to women who have their inner world in order. Not perfection — but self-awareness. He is drawn to quiet elegance, sincerity, and a woman who says what she means.

He is drawn to thoughtful, grounded women who are emotionally balanced, honest, and genuinely invested in the relationship.

To make him feel loved: be consistent and direct. Show your care practically and avoid emotional drama. He reads actions, not declarations.

REFLECT

“Am I with someone who actually sees how much I give — or am I loving someone who takes my care for granted?”

■ VENUS IN LIBRA

Love as harmony, beauty, and being truly equal

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves with grace and needs a relationship that feels like genuine partnership

A woman with Venus in Libra is romantic, refined, and deeply invested in the quality of her relationships. She craves harmony — not by avoiding conflict, but by working through it with care and fairness. She needs a partner who treats her as an equal and brings beauty into the shared space between them.

She feels most loved when she is understood, treated with respect, and the relationship feels balanced rather than one-sided.

To love her well: listen to her, never dismiss her perspective, and invest in the aesthetic and emotional quality of your life together.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to elegance, warmth, and a woman who brings balance

A man with Venus in Libra is captivated by refinement — not just in appearance, but in how a woman carries herself and interacts with the world. He wants a partner who complements him, and with whom life feels graceful rather than chaotic.

He is drawn to classy, warm, and socially at ease women who bring calm rather than conflict into a shared life.

To make him feel loved: be fair and diplomatic, create beauty in your shared environment, and never let the relationship become imbalanced.

REFLECT

“Does this relationship feel like a genuine partnership — or am I doing most of the emotional and relational work?”

■ VENUS IN SCORPIO

Love as depth, truth, and complete surrender

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves with everything — and needs someone who can hold that

A woman with Venus in Scorpio does not do surface. She loves at a depth that most people cannot access, and she needs a partner who does not flinch when things get real. Loyalty is not a preference for her — it is a requirement. And trust, once broken, is rarely fully restored.

She feels most loved when you have chosen her completely, you stay honest even when it is hard, and you do not run from her intensity.

To love her well: earn her trust slowly and protect it carefully. Never play games. She will know — and she will not forget.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to depth, mystery, and emotional power

A man with Venus in Scorpio is not interested in light connections. He is drawn to women who carry emotional complexity, who are not easily read, and who have a depth that rewards real attention. He wants to feel that he is being let in — not performed for.

He is drawn to emotionally complex, magnetic women who are honest about who they are and unafraid of real intimacy.

To make him feel loved: open up genuinely, stay loyal, and never try to control or manage him. He needs to trust fully before he gives fully.

REFLECT

“Am I choosing depth — or am I staying in something intense because leaving feels impossible?”

■ VENUS IN SAGITTARIUS

Love as adventure, growth, and shared meaning

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves freely and needs a relationship that feels expansive

A woman with Venus in Sagittarius needs her relationship to feel like it is going somewhere — not just forward in time, but forward in meaning. She is generous, optimistic, and genuinely loving. But she cannot stay in something that shrinks her. Freedom and growth are not negotiable.

She feels most loved when you are curious about life with her, support her independence, and the relationship has a sense of shared adventure.

To love her well: give her room to be fully herself. Explore ideas together. Never make her choose between love and her own becoming.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to independence, wisdom, and a free spirit

A man with Venus in Sagittarius is attracted to women who have their own rich inner world — opinions, passions, a sense of humour, and a life that does not revolve around him. He needs to feel that being together adds to both their lives, not limits them.

He is drawn to free-spirited, open-minded women who value truth, learning, and genuine laughter.

To make him feel loved: give him freedom without making it a test. Share your real thoughts. Inspire him — do not try to contain him.

REFLECT

“Does this relationship make me feel more myself — or do I sense myself becoming smaller inside it?”

■ VENUS IN CAPRICORN

Love as commitment, respect, and the long game

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves seriously and builds a relationship that lasts

A woman with Venus in Capricorn may seem reserved at first, but her love is one of the most devoted in the zodiac. She is not interested in casual. She wants something real, something she can count on. Respect is her love language — the kind shown through reliability, follow-through, and genuine care for her goals.

She feels most loved when you honour your word, support her ambitions, and treat the relationship with the same seriousness she does.

To love her well: be consistent and dependable. Show her you are in it for the long term through your actions, not your words.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to groundedness, ambition, and quiet strength

A man with Venus in Capricorn is attracted to women who have built something — a career, a clear sense of self, a life with structure and meaning. He respects discipline and is drawn to women who carry themselves with composure.

He is drawn to grounded, capable, and emotionally mature women who are serious about life and not looking for someone to complete them.

To make him feel loved: appreciate his efforts, be consistent, and never mock what he takes seriously. His love lives in his reliability.

REFLECT

“Is this relationship being built — or are we just existing together and calling it commitment?”

■ VENUS IN AQUARIUS

Love as freedom, friendship, and true acceptance

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves unconventionally and needs a partner who genuinely accepts her

A woman with Venus in Aquarius needs her partner to also be her friend — someone who accepts her exactly as she is, who does not try to fit her into a conventional shape. She is loyal and caring, but deeply values her independence and her ability to be fully herself inside a relationship.

She feels most loved when you respect her individuality, give her genuine freedom, and connect with her on an intellectual level.

To love her well: be her ally. Bring ideas into the relationship. Never try to control or possess her — it is the fastest way to lose her.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to originality, intelligence, and a woman who does not need to conform

A man with Venus in Aquarius is not looking for someone conventional. He is drawn to women who think differently, who have their own perspective and are not afraid to express it. He wants connection that feels like freedom, not constraint.

He is drawn to unique, open-minded women who value authenticity and are genuinely comfortable being themselves.

To make him feel loved: give him space, respect his need for independence, and never pressure him into traditional relationship structures before he is ready.

REFLECT

“Do I feel accepted for exactly who I am in this relationship — or am I editing myself to stay?”

■ VENUS IN PISCES

Love as soul, tenderness, and emotional merging

HOW SHE LOVES

She loves with her whole soul and needs to feel like your muse, not your option

A woman with Venus in Pisces is one of the most romantically sensitive placements in the zodiac. She loves deeply, dreams big about love, and gives with a generosity that can sometimes leave her vulnerable. She needs a partner who handles her heart with care — someone who sees her sensitivity as a gift, not a burden.

She feels most loved when you are gentle, emotionally present, and make her feel like being with you is an experience in itself.

To love her well: protect her emotional world. Be soft with her. Show her that her depth is exactly what you came for.

WHAT DRAWS HIM

He is drawn to softness, emotional richness, and spiritual depth

A man with Venus in Pisces is drawn to women who feel like poetry — gentle, expressive, and emotionally generous. He longs for a connection that transcends the ordinary. Logic alone will not move him. He needs to feel something.

He is drawn to compassionate, artistic, and emotionally open women who are not afraid to feel deeply and express it.

To make him feel loved: offer genuine affection, share beauty — in words, music, art, or silence. Make him feel that love with you is a different kind of world.

REFLECT

“Am I with someone who cherishes my sensitivity — or someone who benefits from it without truly seeing it?”

GOING FURTHER

Venus is only one piece of the picture

Your Venus sign gives you a powerful starting point. But your full relationship blueprint also includes your Moon sign (your emotional needs), your Mars sign (what you desire and how you pursue it), and the way your chart interacts with another person's. Two charts can look compatible on paper and feel completely wrong in practice. Or they can look complicated and work beautifully. The nuance is in the full reading.
